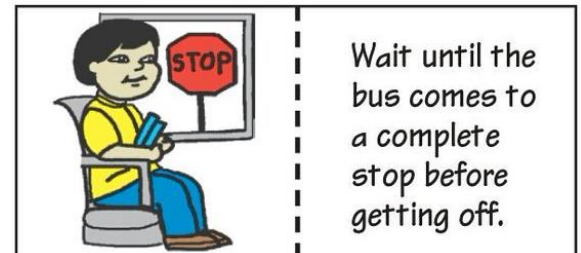
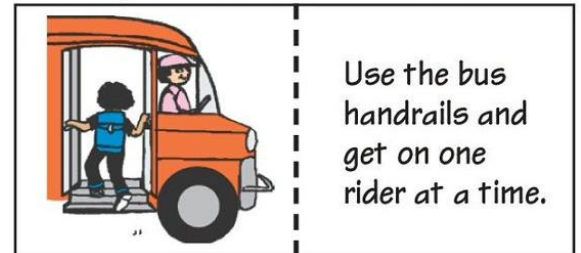
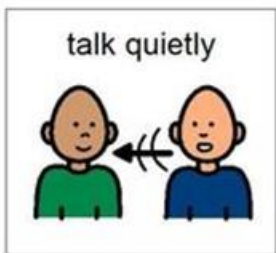


BUS DISCIPLINE GUIDELINES

- Respect the bus driver and always listen to him.
- Respect and obey the Bus Assistant on duty at all times.
- Board the bus quietly and carefully.
- Be polite, speak quietly and refrain from shouting or speaking loudly to disturb others, or the drivers to drive safely.
- Avoiding pushing each other.
- Place bags and parcels under/over your seat or on your lap.
- Sit properly in the assigned seat facing forward at all times.
- Seatbelts must be worn. Students should only remove seatbelts when the bus comes to a complete stop.
- Students are not allowed to recline seatbacks and/or place their feet on the seatback in front of them
- Keep the aisle of the bus clear at all times.
- Always keep your head, hands and arms inside the bus.
- Throwing objects inside or outside of the bus is not permitted.
- While on the bus, all electronic devices must be used in silent mode or with earphones at a noise level that allows them to still hear instructions from the Bus Assistant.



Bus Reminders



Eating, drinking, chewing gum, playing with dangerous or sharp toys, applying make-up, and/or any other activity that may threaten the safety of any passenger on the bus, is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.

Any act of indiscipline will lead to disciplinary and administrative action as per the student behavior policy and bus policy of the school.
